- There is no cost to attend, and travel and lodging is provided for Fellows outside of Maricopa County.








Flinn-Brown Network

Application Requirements



- Only Arizona residents are eligible to apply.
- Applications will be available on our <u>website</u> from February 1 through February 28.
- The application includes four essay prompts regarding the applicant's:
 - civic-leadership experience,
 - approach to a policy issue,
 - future civic-leadership goals, and
 - response to today's political climate.



Application Requirements



- Applicants must also submit by February 28:
 - a current resume,
 - a 20 second introductory video (shot on a computer or mobile device) regarding your interest in the Flinn-Brown Fellowship,
 - a headshot, and
 - two endorsement letters.
- Applicants must acknowledge their ability to attend <u>all</u> Academy sessions in the fall.
- Please note: If selected for an interview, the applicant's employer will be required to submit the Employer Approval Form.
